

The women begin a journey to the tomb of Jesus in the dawn of Sunday.

Mark 16:1, Luk 24:10

Matt 28:2-4

Luk 24:4-7, Mark 16:8

Matt 28:11-15

An earthquake shakes the tomb, an angel rolls the stone away, and the roman guards become like dead men.

The women arrive to find angels at the tomb who tell them Jesus is not there. The women leave to tell the Apostles.

The roman guards return and tell the religious leaders. The leaders bribe them to keep quiet and spread a lie about the fate of the body of Jesus.

Peter and John go back with the women to the tomb. They discover the empty tomb. The Apostles leave but the women stay behind.

Eight days later, Jesus appears to His disciples and Apostles for a second time. Thomas is now present.

The Apostles encounter Jesus a third time at the beach in Galilee. Jesus forgives Peter.

The Apostles meet Jesus at the Mount of Olives.

Jesus leads the disciples to Bethany where He blesses them and ascends to Heaven.
