

Library News



Earlier this month a planetary alignment occurred in the Western sky around sunset. A planetary alignment means a certain number of planets appear across the sky in an orderly fashion. In this case it was Jupiter, Mercury, Venus, Uranus, and Mars. We were happy for clear skies, but were only able to identify Venus, Mercury, & Mars...the others were not apparent to us. Even so, we enjoyed our purposeful viewing of the early night sky.

God made the universe beautiful and unimaginably large. I wonder if that's why God uses the night sky to illustrate and explain His greatness to us. After looking at the planets that night, I've made it a point to get out in the dark and look up. I've also made it a point to look at scriptures that refer to the stars. Here are some of my favorites.

If he commands it, the sun won't rise, and the stars won't shine. He alone has spread out the heavens and marches on the waves of the sea. He made all the stars—the Bear and Orion, the Pleiades, and the constellations of the southern sky. He does great things too marvelous to understand. He performs countless miracles. Job 9:7-10 (NLT)

When I look at the night sky and see the work of your fingers—the moon and the stars you set in place—what are mere mortals that you should think about them, human beings that you should care for them? Yet you made them only a little lower than God and crowned them with glory and honor. Psalms 8:3-5 (NLT)

The heavens proclaim the glory of God. The skies display his craftsmanship. Day after day they continue to speak; night after night they make him known. They speak without a sound or word; their voice is never heard. Yet their message has gone throughout the earth, and their words to all the world. God has made a home in the heavens for the sun. It bursts forth like a radiant bridegroom after his wedding. It rejoices like a great athlete eager to run the race. The sun rises at one end of the heavens and follows its course to the other end. Nothing can hide from its heat. Psalms 19:1-6 (NLT)

He counts the stars and calls them all by name. How great is our Lord! His power is absolute! His understanding is beyond comprehension! Psalms 147:3-5 (NLT)

The size and beauty of the universe reflect the incomprehensibility of God. Romans 1:20 tells us the invisible attributes of God can be recognized from the things which He made, so it's not a surprise that the universe is so incredible. Truly the heavens declare the glory of God and the skies proclaim the work of His hands!
